Yet in the light of the global pandemic and with the unforeseen ripple effect thereof, the planning committee of the conference had to make another difficult decision regarding the planned conference for May 2021. Because of funding cuts and the continued uncertainty regarding travel and in person meetings, it was decided to change the time and format of the conference to an online symposium on 2-3 November 2022.

Postgraduate students in the MTh program in Dialogical Intergenerational Pastoral Process (DIPP) program will be afforded the opportunity to present papers with the aim to further Africanise the program. A team of international advisers will attend online to reply to these inputs.

The symposium is organised by the sub-discipline of pastoral care and counselling within the Department of Practical Theology and Missiology, Faculty of Theology, Stellenbosch University. The DIPP has been a central focus of the department since 2017. This master programme focuses specifically on Contextual Pastoral Care and Counselling, in the track of Dr Ivan Boszormenyi-Nagy (1920-2007), main founder of Contextual Therapy.
